Horse Fair: The Committee were informed by the Clerk of the concern of residents regarding the proposed plan to hold the Horse Fair after the 21st of June 2021. Residents are concerned that a mass gathering with an indeterminable number of people visiting Appleby in the early days of COVID recovery was very worrying. This would also affect the issuing of the Grazing licence for Fair Hill. The Committee acknowledge that post 21 June it is envisaged that all restrictions may be removed allowing gathering of any size. It was recommended to wait until the MASCG group reached a decision at the end of March before issuing the grazing licence. The Clerk has passed all residents' concerns to the Chairman of MASCG.
