PR1/04/24 Apologies for Absence

Apologies received from Cllr Connell, Cllr Curley and Cllr Potts.

PR2/04/24 Declarations of Interest

Cllr Anderton declared a personal interest in Fair Hill, as her property borders the land.

PR4/04/24 Chairman's Report

PR5/04/24 Public Hall Update

No further work has taken place on the Public Hall since the last meeting,

PR6/04/24 Dowpitts Wood

The Clerk reported a complaint has been received from a local tree surgeon: that he was not asked to tender for work carried out at Dowpitts Wood. He also felt it is bad practice to commission the same company to carry out the work, who had carried out the survey and made the recommendations about what work needed doing.

The Clerk has replied to the complainant to give a breakdown of what work was carried out and at what cost. Also to explain the Council's procurement policy and that we would only advertise contracts on the Government procurement portal for work above £30,000.

The Clerk had also taken advice from W&F Contracts Team regarding commissioning work with the company who had carried out the survey and they confirmed that this was perfectly acceptable.

The Clerk also informed the committee that an Officer from the Woodland Trust would be visiting the woods later in the week.

- Cllr Anderton asked at what stage the gates at the top of Fair Hill should be locked. The Clerk confirmed she would look back at last year and confirm the dates, as the water testing still
